

Objects and purposes of the Association are to:

- (a) promote and foster the sport of bicycle racing;
- (b) promote, organise and conduct bicycle races and events for cyclists; and
- (c) provide social activities for the benefit of members and their guests.

The Following modifications to the Model Rules have been approved by the Association and replace all previous modifications to the Model Rules.

Rule	Modified to Read
1	The name of the Association shall be the Hobart Wheelers/Dirt Devils Incorporated.
3	The office of the Association shall be or such other place as the committee may from time to time determine.
5	Membership of the Association (1) A member of the Association is any person who is a financial member of Cycling Australia (CA) or Mountain Bike Australia Ltd (MTBA) with the Association nominated as their chosen cycling club. (2) A member of the Association may cease to be a member by: <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) no longer being a financial member of CA or MTBA; or(b) applying to the Association secretary or CA or MTBA and completing a transfer to another club; or(c) by being expelled under rule 34.
6(3)	Any liability under subrule (2) is not to exceed one dollar.
9(1)	The treasurer of the Association is to cause any money received on behalf of the Association to be paid into the account opened under subrule (2) as soon as practicable after it is received.
9(7)	A cheque, draft, bill of exchange, promissory note or other negotiable instrument is to be signed by two officers of the Association.
9(8)	An electronic transfer of an amount from the Association's account to another account at an authorised deposit-taking institution may only be authorised by the treasurer.
25(1)	The committee shall consist of the officers of the Association.
28(1)	The committee shall meet at least once in every three months at such place and at such times as the committee may determine.
28(2)	A meeting of the committee, other than a meeting referred to in subrule (1), may be convened by the president or any 3 of the members of the committee.
28(5)	A quorum for the transaction of the business of a meeting of the committee is 3 members of the committee.

31(2) During the period between meetings of the committee the president may take such steps as may be reasonably necessary in the interests of the Association in matters of urgency connected with the management of the affairs of the Association.

30(4) A committee member is to convene meetings of a subcommittee.

31(3) The president is to report on any instructions issued under subrule (2) to the next meeting of the committee.

32 **Club Fees**

The annual CA and MTBA club fee will be determined by the committee.
