C. The following modifications to the Model Rules have been approved by the Association.

1	The name of the Association shall be Hobart Amateur Cycle Club $$ Inc.	
3	The office of the Association shall be at 336 Murray Street, Hobart or such other place as the committee may, from time to time, determine.	
5(11)(b)	Every person who, within the period of twelve months immediately preceding the commencement of the winding up, was a member of the Association, is liable to contribute to the assets of the Association for payment of the debts or liabilities of the Association and for the costs, charges, and expenses of the winding up and for the adjustment of the rights of the contributories among themselves such sum, not exceeding one dollar as may be required, but a former member is not liable so to contribute in respect of any debt or liability of the Association contracted after he ceased to be a member.	
14(3)	Five members personally present (being members entitled under these rules to vote thereat) constitute a quorum for the transaction of the business of a general meeting.	
23(1)	The Committee shall consist of the officers of the Association.	
26(1)	The Committee shall meet at least once in every three months at such place and at such times as the Committee may determine.	
26(2)	Special meetings of the Committee may be convened by the President or any three of its members.

- Any three members of the Committee constitute a quorum for the transaction of the business of a meeting of the Committee.
- The President as chief executive may take such steps as may be reasonably necessary in the interests of the Association in matters of urgency connected with the management of the affairs of the Association during the interval between meetings of the Committee, and where any such steps are taken shall report thereon to the next meeting of the Committee.
- 29(1) Until otherwise fixed pursuant to sub-rule (2) of this rule, the annual subscription payable by members shall be the sum of three dollars.
  - The financial year of the Association is the period beginning on 1 April in each year and ending on the 31 March next following.
